

## RULES FOR VENDORS

---

1. Read and complete the registration form and sign the release.
2. Agree to the following rules:  
THESE RULES WILL BE FOLLOWED OR BOOTHS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO OPEN AND/OR ASKED TO LEAVE THE GROUNDS WITHOUT A REFUND.
  - a. Pay space rent – outside or in Beef Arena 20' X 20', \$45 per space.
  - b. Two gate passes are included with the booth space rental. Extra 3-day passes are \$10 each.
  - c. Direct **ALL** problems or questions to the registration office for proper handling.
  - d. All vendors are responsible for taxes on items sold. We will provide the tax forms. Your name and address will be turned in to the Oklahoma Tax Commission at the end of the show.
  - e. All vendors using heating devices must have fire extinguishers (current inspection) in their booths.
  - f. There are some items that are strictly prohibited at our show. These will not be sold under any circumstances.
    - Any device that shoots or squirts water
    - Any device which is illegal (throwing stars, fireworks, etc.)
    - Any pornographic materials. If you have any doubt, don't display or sell that item.
    - Alcoholic beverages
    - Firearms or knives
  - g. Vendors will set up Thursday before the show between 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
  - h. Vendors are responsible for keeping their area clean during the show and before leaving the grounds.
  - i. No vehicles will be **PARKED** on the show grounds. There is designated vendor parking just outside the west gate.
3. A speed limit of 5 mph has been set for **ALL** vehicles on the show grounds. This speed limit is in effect beginning at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday and continuing through midnight Sunday.
4. If you wish to have a golf cart, ATV, mule or similar type transportation and use it between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on the show grounds, you must have the following:
  1. Handicap Tag in or on the type of transportation you are wishing to use.
  2. Certificate of Insurance with language which specifically details the coverage of the type of transportation you are wishing to use.

You must register in the Registration Office. You will receive a special tag to be placed on your type of transportation. All golf carts, ATV's, mules, etc that do not have this information will be asked to park until after 6 p.m.
